



LOCAL RULES

Hole 1

Road to left is OB OB stakes to the right

Hole 2

OB marked by white line, left of cart path. Water/creek area to the right side of fairway is a hazard.

Hole 3

Water to the right of the hole is a hazard

Hole 4

Drop Zone available after tee shot for the SR+ category only

Hole 6

If the ball comes to rest in the hazard area (the area that looks like a dried up lake), the player has the following options:

 \cdot Play as it lies using the hazard kick.

 \cdot Remove the ball to the Drop Zone with a 1 stroke penalty.

• If the ball is resting in CASUAL WATER (as defined in rule 3-2-3), the player may choose to take relief in the hazard using the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole. This will be free relief with no penalty. The entirety of the golf green and fairway area is considered the FootGolf green.

Hole 8

Area to left of fairway is considered waste area.

Hole 9

There is a sprinkler head on the green. Players may take free relief if the sprinkler is in their intended line of play.

Hole 12

Drop Zone available after tee shot for the SR+ and Women's categories only.

Hole 14

Entirety of the bowl behind the hole is considered the FootGolf green.

Hole 15

If the ball comes to rest on or touching the large rock feature in front of the hole, the player is entitled to free relief to be taken in the Drop Zone. OB over fence of solar farm.

Hole 16

OB to the left of the cart path.

Hole 18

OB to the right of the cart path from the location of the first bunker.
